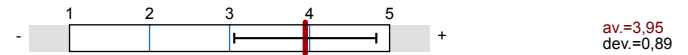

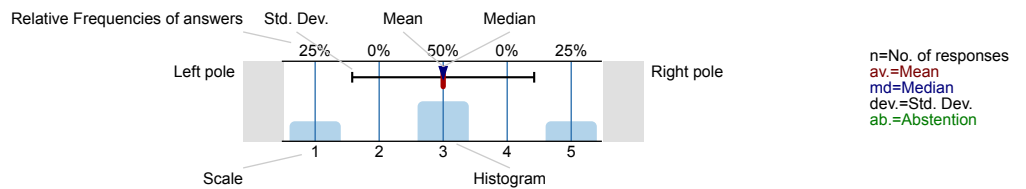

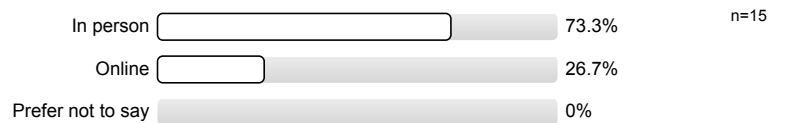

1.1) How often I attended class.

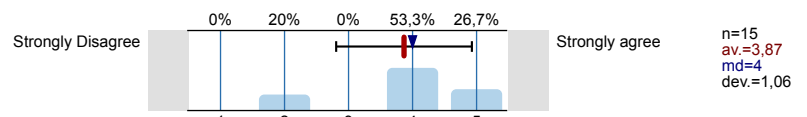

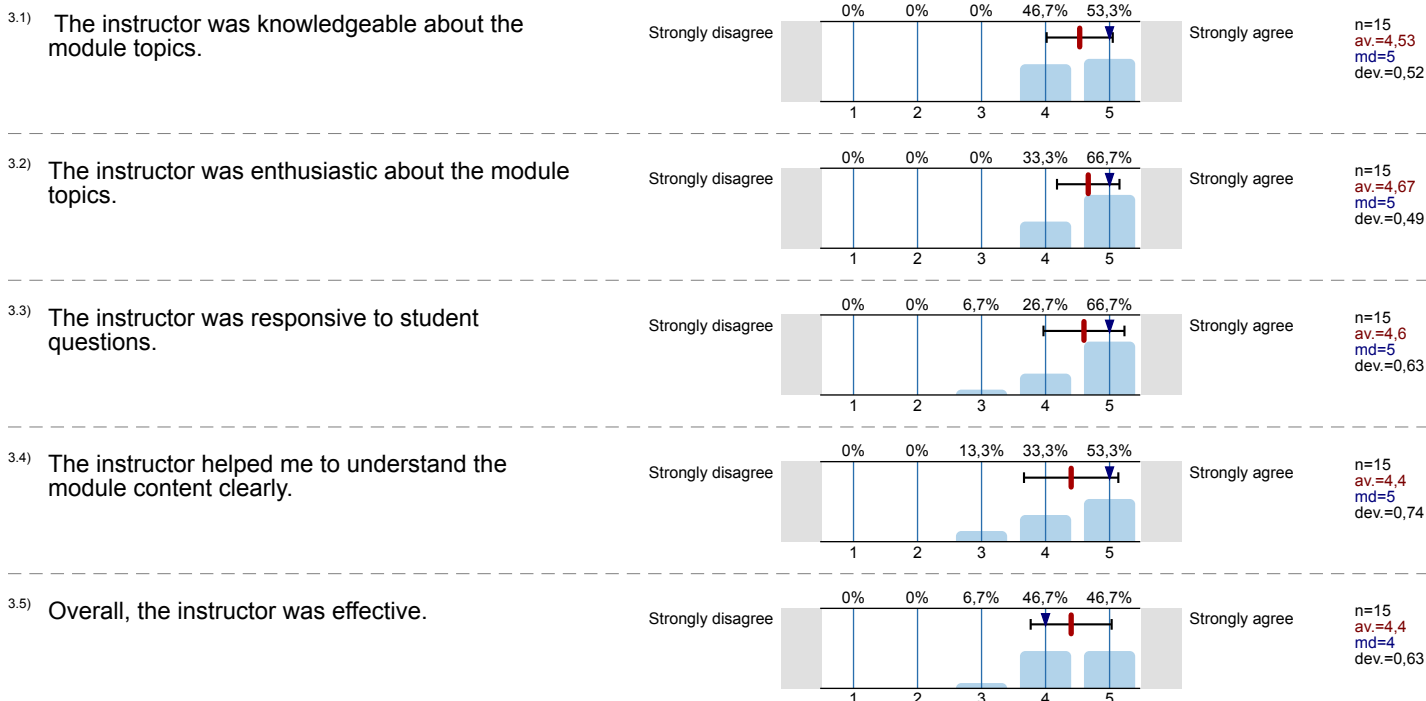

 - Laure gave very clear instructions of the assignments, was responsive to students questions and feedback across the module and made the topic interesting
 - The lecturer is very open to discuss new topics that the students are interested in.
- 5.2) What would you most like to improve in this module?
- As my background is not about health care so it would be better if more topics on health care are covered and explained in detail.
 - I majoritarily liked everything! Its a bit of a pity that we have to hand in the two assignments when Laure is not going to be able to answer our emails
 - The learning objectives were not very clear to me. I feel like I did not learn as many new things as I did in the other courses. The assignments focused strongly on scientific research and writing (discussing causality etc.) but I am not sure if that is what students really expected from the course and what they are interested in.
 - The module has a very strong focus on the individual assignment. I believe this takes a bit of valuable time from other key and interesting topics which could be discussed within the context of healthcare analytics.
 - The module was too structured around us coming to the professor with our progress on the assignment. I didn't feel I learned much about healthcare analytics specifically. Since we were using analytics tools and concepts from our previous classes- it seems that these concepts were repetitive. For future cohorts perhaps it can be more healthcare centric and not so general.
 - There is no additional learning in the module, the entire focus is on assignments.
